This report covers an extended period as we have changed to use the usual UK accounting year ending on 5th April. I gave an interim treasurer's report at the last AGM on 12th September 2022, which covered the 6 months to 30th June 2022, the end of our time as part of the IBM Club organisation.

This report period covers the move of the club's bank account from NatWest to Lloyds. That incurred no costs (nor benefits), and does not affect this report. We made a few test transactions to show the correct operation of transfers between these accounts, but they were all reversed, so their net effect was 0 and they do not appear in this report.

The Rambling club ceased to be a separate subsection with its own account during last year. The remaining funds were transferred to us, as shown in the income and expense sheet.

Events in the first part of 2023, the ethnic lunch at the Giggling Squid, the ramble lunch, were all self-funded, and money neither entered nor left the club account.
